

PARENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT

I hereby pledge to provide support, care and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parents Code of Conduct:

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, board members and officials at every game, practice or other youth sporting event.
- I will do my best to make youth sports fun for my child and I will not ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- I will require my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I understand the bond between a coach and a player is key to the coaching process. I will not disparage my child's coach in the presence of my child in order not to undermine my child's relationship with his or her coach. I recognize the importance of volunteer coaches and treat them with respect at all times. I recognize that without them the Tamarac Cougars cease to exist.
- I will work to eliminate physical and verbal abuse in youth sports, starting with my own behavior.
- I will abide by the rules and regulations of the TYFL, its Bylaws, and the Bylaws of any associated youth sports league.
- I understand that drugs, alcohol and gambling has no place in youth sports. I will not bring drugs or alcohol to practices or games, including parking lots adjacent to practices or games, in either open or closed containers.
- > I will not consume alcohol immediately before attending practices or games.
- > I will remember that the game is for my child, not for me.

I have read and understand to the above policies and acknowledge and agree to all of them with the understanding that if I fail to adhere to these policies it can result in immediate removal from the park and possible suspension from games if not up to and/or including removal from the Tamarac Cougars Youth Football and Cheerleading program.
